RENEESGOTZIP sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail, turned back a bid from the inside leaving the backstretch, responded when challenged on the turn, spurted clear again passing the quarter pole, drifted out into the stretch, drifted in from the whip while widening in midstretch and drew off under urging. MADE TO LOVE HER stalked the pace inside then outside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and gained the place late. PAINTED WOMAN away alertly, surrendered the advantage and stalked between horses then bid inside a half mile out, tracked the winner along the rail on the turn and in the stretch and was overtaken late for second. ROWDY GAL had speed off the rail then stalked between rivals, bid between horses on the turn and weakened in the stretch. CANDREA stalked four wide then three deep leaving the backstretch, bid three wide on the turn and also weakened in the drive. LADY HOKULEA broke inward and slowly, pulled her way along off the rail then between horses and steadied sharply midway on the backstretch, chased just off the rail into and on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
