I'M BOUNDTOSCORE, up to duel on the backstretch, moved clear quickly, set a reserved pace on the turn then held sway under intermittent encouragement. ARE YOU KIDDING ME raced in midpack, chased three-wide into the stretch, angled out upper stretch and rallied gamely. INDIANO JONES, prominent early, stalked the pace three-wide on the turn and finished determinedly through the stretch. BEST PLAY, rated off the pace, saved ground, was hustled into the str and finished gamely along the rail. THE B'S AND E'S, prominent early, stalked the leader on the turn, failed with a bid between foes at the top of the stretch, chased, but evened out late. MERCENARY settled in midpack, chased four-wide late turn then lacked a strong closing response. ARCHER HILL, rated off the pace, closed three to five-wide through the turn then evened out in the late stages. BEAR'S FURR stalked the pace, chased between rivals late turn then flattened out in the final furlong.
