Bay Horse, (Apr), by Greatness - Cat Attack by Storm Cat. Trainer Ward A. Wesley. Bred by Edward Seltzer & Murray Durst (FL).

GREAT ATTACK settled back off the pace while off the inside, commenced his run when given his cue mid turn, angled out and was deftly maneuvered through a seam in upper stretch, worked further out for clear running soon after, responded to stout left handed pressure, closed relentlessly while drifting in briefly a sixteenth out and surged past BRIDGETOWN in the final yards. BRIDGETOWN, brushed at the break, disputed the pace inside rivals while under a rating hold, spurred well clear in mid stretch while off the rail, finished gamely but could not withstand the winner's charge. CACTUS SON, brushed at the start, saved ground, eased out in upper stretch, split rivals leaving the furlong marker, angled in a bit and closed willingly. GREAT MILLS, three wide between horses contesting the early pace, pressed outside BRIDGETOWN to the head of the stretch then faded. SPINNING MOVE, off slowly, lagged back, swung extremely wide for the drive and finished with good energy. CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE was acting up in the gate prior to the start, came away a beat slow, lost ground five and six wide, made slight progress into the lane then came up empty. STORMY GOING, between rivals nearing the turn, was not a factor. AMANECER DE ORO chased the pace three to four wide, made a mild run inside the three sixteenths marker then flattened out. SANTO GATO, towards the inside, lacked a response. SHABAAB forced the pace four wide to the quarter pole then gave way. SPEIGHT THE HALO chased the pace three wide and dropped back between horses approaching the lane. CITY SAGE broke inward brushing with BRIDGETOWN, rushed up between foes to pop a head in front after three sixteenths of a mile, had little to give around the turn, faltered and was eased late.
