POINT TAKEN along the inside initially, was placed into the two path midway down the backstretch, stalked the front runners, while being rated along, continued along on the same scenario upon reaching the turn, was put to some urging and taken over to the rail shortly after spinning into the lane, sat boxed in amongst rivals from the three-sixteenths pole to near the furlong marker, had the inside route open slightly but enough and slipped past the runner up, kicked away thereafter. LUBANGO settled near the rail, vied for command with another duo parked out in the two paths to his outside almost from the get-go, with all three front runners not being asked for run, had the closest pursuers make their presence felt more as the third fraction was being recorded, turned for home and got called upon, drifted out a bit while making his way through the furlong grounds, got reeled in by the rail-rallying winner leaving the eighth pole, but continued onward in a willing manner to secure second. MAGIC HARBOR off the rail throughout, was already under solid encouragement taking the four path for entrance into the stretch, flattened out in the final furlong. DIVINE CHILD contested the pace from between rivals to the quarter pole before backing away. BLUE CREEK three wide departing the backstretch, was gradually taken inward starting from the five-sixteenths pole, cut the corner into the stretch and came up empty. GIANT INDIAN three wide, disputed the pace as the widest of a threesome for six furlongs and tired. J W BLUE kept a watchful eye on the front runners from the four path until late on the turn, folded. I LOVE IT away awkwardly, trailed throughout.

AVENGING SPIRIT assumed a forward spot in the opening stages, fought against the bit while under restraint by the pilot as HEWITTS

was being guided over to the inside, then got steadied, once that opponent did so, in the vicinity of the nine-sixteenths pole, was placed into the two path almost immediately afterwards and gave chase, closed in and issued a challenge for control leaving the midway point on the bend, took over before reaching the quarter pole, under some urging, but much less so than the displaced former leader, entered the stretch and was set down to a drive, drifted out a couple of paths after being on the receiving end of some left handed stick work in upper stretch, had the rider switch the stick to opposite side and went as straight as an arrow thereafter, departed the eighth pole holding his biggest advantage and remained comfortably clear to the end. TERMINUS got away a beat slowly, was three wide entering the turn and four wide exiting it, rallied to garner the place, although never posing a serious threat to the top one in the late stages. SHMOOZ TALKER broke alertly, but rapidly dropped back in the early going, rode the rail until the top of the turn, was cued up and angled outward, got taken outward more sharply prior to spinning into the lane, until in the five path by the head of the stretch, ran into contention during the ensuing furlong before flattening out. KING ROCK placed onto the inside route at the end of the backstretch, failed to muster up the needed response off the subsequent ground-saving journey. WILLY PAY chased outside and tired. THE MIXER two wide and asked for a response at the three-eighths, had no pick up in speed. BWANA BOOYAH was quickly sent over towards the inside after the start but not entirely over to the rail, chased the front runners three wide until halfway around the bend, couldn't keep up anymore and folded. HEWITTS grabbed the lead a short distance out of the starting gate, tucked along the rail coming to the end of the backstretch, with the eventual winner, along the rail at time, steadying in the process, came under the rapt attention of that rival after going onward for only a couple of additional strides, yielded when put to the test late on turn, faded in the lane, was pulled up and unsaddled only an eighth past the wire, got walked off then was reported to have bled.

BLONDE BLITZEN away well at the start, cut the pace coaxed along two to three wide, inched away in the latter portion of the turn, got the reins shaken up at the head of the stretch, continued to expand on the margin steadily until the final furlong, dug in getting a bit weary in the very late stages, saw her margin cut into while put to an offside stick in the final strides to hold safe and prevail. GROUP THERAPY bumped at the start by MEA MAXIMA CULPA who broke inward, settled just off the pace two to three wide, came under urging at the three-eighths pole, got bumped and pushed six wide in upper stretch by KIMMIES LUCKY STAR, offered up mild belated energy to secure the place honors in the last jumps. FU PEGGI SUE saved ground towards the rear, came under a drive at the five-sixteenths and advanced from there to reach contention a furlong out, offered up a mild rally to secure the show. MINI MUFFIN tracked the pace the closest pursuer from just off the inside, got set down angling four wide in upper stretch, remained prominent to the eighth pole before weakening in the final furlong. KIMMIES LUCKY STAR three wide just off the pace urged from three furlongs out, angled five wide in upper stretch bumping GROUP THERAPY to the six path then weakened in the drive. BORN SUNDAY three to four wide in mid pack, commenced a long drive from the seven-sixteenths while taking the overland route through the turn and tired. MEA MAXIMA CULPA brushed the near side stall at the start when breaking inwards then bumped GROUP THERAPY, settled inside towards the rear, shifted to be four wide at the seven-sixteenths, came under urging three furlongs out, angled back to the inside nearing the quarter pole and tired in the stretch. PATRIOT'S JEWEL hesitated at the start, was outrun early on racing last and detached and proved no factor.

UNDERGROUNDREGULATR along the inside, vied to maintain a slim lead, well rated for the opening half, shook free of an energetically-handled BIZARROWORLD during the later stages of the run around the bend, to arrive at the quarter pole with none being latched on, spun into the lane and was called upon, drew off. BOLD FOREST settled into midpack after the start, was already under solid encouragement turning for home four wide, proved no match for the winner while finishing well clear of the others for place honors. BOLD AND READY was put to some urging nearly from the get-go, got sharply sent over to the rail from the three path in the vicinity of the nine-sixteenths pole, launched a rail run to reach a good striking striking position a quarter down the road, was angled sharply for a second time, this time back into the three path, entered the stretch and continued to pursue the winner in earnest, failed to keep pace and backed away. KELTIC FIGHTER was well reserved for nearly a half, travelled three wide for most of the way around the turn, fanned outward turning for home until in the five path midway through the furlong grounds, lacked the needed response. BIZARROWORLD disputed the pace outside the winner just about from the start until the five-sixteenths pole, failed to keep up despite getting asked for some run at that station and gave way. PSYCH MAJOR off the inside, was no menace. READYSETKETCH four wide departing the backstretch, tired. CHICS PALACE off to a sluggish start, raced along the outside, spun four wide into upper stretch to no avail.

FREEDOM CHILD near the rear of a tightly-bunched group right after the start, rushed up along the inside under the mildest of hand urging to take control before reaching the end of the chute, cut the pace towards the inside but always kept at a slight distance from off the rail, extended the margin on the turn having no need of encouragement, started to drift out prior to the quarter pole with the closest four pursuers all under a strong drive at this juncture, commenced the stretch about three wide, was given his cue and responded positively, continued to drift outward, almost steadily, while drawing away convincingly, with the pilot applying some strong right handed stick work as a corrective measure, particularly once past the eighth pole, to no avail. SAINT VIGEUR chased the winner from the two path on the turn, was taken over to the inside and cut the corner into the stretch, vacated the inside soon afterwards, held on well for the place. GO GET THE BASIL off the inside, came five wide into the stretch, mustered up a mild response for the show. ABRAHAM off the inside throughout, was under a drive turning for home four wide, had no rally. INCOGNITO near the two path on the turn, was guided over to the rail in midstretch, made no impact. FEAR THE KITTEN urged early, failed to pick up the pace and was never in contention. MY NAME IS MICHAEL stalked afar outside the winner, was under a drive undertaking the task on the turn, tired. NARVAEZ saved ground, left the half mile pole already put to encouragement, faltered. INFINITE MAGIC inside on the turn, had little left for the stretch.

DERBY WATCH crossed to the inside after the start, spurred away along the inside, widened away in the latter part of the turn as the field spread out giving chase, got set down at the head of the lane and went further clear under a drive to the wire. SCANDALO saved ground chasing from afar, advanced through the turn urged from midway, was along for the place through the final furlong while never threatening the top. FREIGHT two to three wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under urging three furlongs out and was along for the show. LAST RUN chased inside from towards the rear ridden along from the three-eighths pole, offered up mild energy for the last major share. MOONSHINE RIDGE chased inside pushed along from three furlongs out and weakened in the final eighth. NELTHERION broke in at the start bumping with HARRY CONSOLIDATOR, chased two to three wide towards the rear and offered no response. ACRO'S GAME three wide in mid pack urged along from midway on the turn, spun four wide in upper stretch and weakened. SMOKEY BROWN squeezed between rivals at the start, was outrun early on and was never involved. ECONOMIC FORECAST hustled at the start, chased from just off the inside under a prolonged drive from the seven-sixteenths and gave way at the head of the stretch. HARRY CONSOLIDATOR broke in at the start bumping and squeezing SMOKEY BROWN back against FREIGHT, raced three wide and proved no factor.
