A Supplementary Nomination of \$3,000 may be made on Wednesday, September 4, 2013, which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$750 to pass t he entry box and an additional \$750 to start, with \$150,000 Guaranteed; after payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last. 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. **WEIGHT:** 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 once, allowed 2 lbs.; \$35,000 once or a race other than Maiden or Claiming, allowed 4 lbs. This event will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Highweights preferred. Preference of horses of equ al weight will be Highest Total Earnings in 2013 Failure to draw into this race at time of entry cancels all fees with the exception of the nominating fee(s). Starters to be named through the entry box by usual time of closing. Two (2) horses having commo n ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single ownership interest. Trophy to the owner of the winner. Nominations Closed Wednesday, August 28, 2013 with 28. (Cloudy 85)

SOLITARY RANGER broke sharply, was rated attending a rival's pace a bit off the inside in the opening half, continued with a steady bid to force the issue on the turn, edged away to a clear advantage racing into upper stretch and drew well clear late under firm left handed encouragement. WHYRUAWESOME, held up off the second flight while shifting to the inside in the opening stages, steadily advanced to contention along the rail racing into the turn, shifted out nearing upper stretch to briefly challenge the leader from between foes, angled to the rail while continuing under pressure through the stretch but couldn't match terms with the winner. CEE 'N O was rated tracking the leaders along the inside in the opening half, switched off the rail racing through the turn while losing some position, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch and continued with an effort to gain some position while proving no threat to the top pair. CAPTAIN'S AFFAIR (IRE) settled last in the opening half, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch to split foes three wide gaining some position racing into the lane but made no real impression on the leaders. HIGH ROLL, held up between foes tracking just off the first flight, was herded out three deep between foes racing into upper stretch and quickly came up empty. JOEDINI angled inwards a bit in the early stages to track the leaders three deep in the second flight but faded from contention early. LOTSA MISCHIEF moved to the fore along the inside to dictate the pace on a narrow margin racing into the bend but quickly gave way once headed by the winner.
