1 1/4 MILES. (1.404) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 *CENTRAL BANK ASHLAND S. (GRADE I) FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD.* By subscription of \$100 each on or before February 23, 2013 or \$1,000 each on or before March 27, 2013. A Supplementary Nomination of \$25,000 each may be made at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$2,500 to enter and an additional \$2,500 to start, with \$500,000 guaranteed, of which \$300,000 to the owner of the winner, \$100,000 to second, \$50,000 to third, \$25,000 to fourth, \$15,000 to fifth and \$10,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 121 lbs. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2013 Kentucky Oaks, pursuant to the official rules for the Kentucky Oaks published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. The maximum number of starters for the Central Bank Ashland will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner. A silver julep cup will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. Closed, Saturday, February 23, 2013 with 135 nominations. (Cloudy 60)

Bay Filly, (Feb), by Empire Maker - Soothing Touch by Touch Gold. Trainer Mott I. William. Bred by Juddmonte Farms, Inc.(KY). EMOLLIENT sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace near the rail and drew off under a steady hand ride. TUTTIPAESI (IRE) outrun early, made a solid inside middle move but could not sustain the bid and held on for the place. KITTEN'S POINT within striking distance among rivals, improved her position while no threat. WAVE THEORY carried eight wide into the first turn, was outrun, made a rive wide run after five furlongs but could not threaten late. KITTEN'S DUMPLINGS outrun early four wide, made a good move in that path on the second turn but tired in the drive. NIPISSING within striking distance off the rail, tired in the drive. BROKEN SPELL stumbled at the start, was outrun early, saved ground rallying on the second turn but could not sustain the bid. SPRING VENTURE was no threat. SPRING IN THE AIR forwardly placed three wide, gave way. ALLANA H drifted seven wide early failed to menace. PRIVATE ENSIGN forwardly placed along the inside, stopped after a half. REDRESSTHEBALANCE (IRE) close up off the rail, moved to the inside on the second turn and faded. EVERY WAY closest to the pace three wide, stopped.
