A supplemental nomination fee of \$5,000 in addition to the entry fee may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,250 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstake in 2013; or \$100,000; or \$50,000 twice all owed 3 lbs.; \$60,000 other than restricted stake; or \$40,000 in 2013, 5 lbs.; \$30,000; or three races other than maiden or claiming, 7 lbs. DECLAN'S WARRIOR was allowed to settle into stride, picked up interest after going the initial quarter, tipped into the two path midway around the bend and was put to some light hand urging, swung outward turning for home until five wide at the top of the lane, got straightened away and kicked in with good energy closing in rapidly on the front runners, continued onward, was the primary pursuer with about a sixteenth to go, shied outward in response to the drifting antics coming from CLEARLY NOW in deep stretch, showed good courage nevertheless and got up at the wire. CLEARLY NOW bobbed at the start, moved up into a forward position, disputed the pace as the widest of a threesome, with another trio giving chase only a slight distance from behind, got called upon spinning into the lane, still hooked up a spirited tussle, shook free with a burst of energy a short distance from the eighth pole, drifted out several paths, with the eventual winner following suit, dug in with good determination, but was nailed. THE TRUTH AND K G chased the front running threesome three wide on the turn, tipped a bit wider heading for the top of the lane, launched a menacing run from there to the furlong marker, flattened out. SALUTOS AMIGOS contested the pace from between opponents to midstretch before weakening. HONORABLE DILLON raced along the outside and improved position with a mild kick. MALEEH came inward, bumping with CLAWBACK at the start, chased the front runners from between rivals on the turn and tired. RETRIEVE along the rail, argued for command with another pair to the outside until upper stretch before backing away. CLAWBACK made contact with MALEEH at the start, tracked the front runners from the pocket, was let out a notch near the seven-sixteenths pole, had the rider resume the previous firm hold shortly afterwards and remain under it the rest of the way around the turn, found room to ease two wide entering the stretch, was called upon and failed to fire. SILVER MORGAN three wide and put to encouragement at the three-eighths pole, tired.
