

1 1/4 MILES. (1.452) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 BELDAME INVITATIONAL S. (GRADE I) FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By invitation only with no subscription fees. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. The Beldame Invitational has been selected as one of the Breeders' Cup Win and You're In Challenge Races. The nominated winner of the Beldame Invitational will be entitled to automatic entry into the 2013 running of the Breeders' Cup Ladies Classic, nominated winner will be entitled to have pre-entry and entry fees waived for the Championship race, and will be entitled to receive a travel stipend if traveling from a base located outside the state of California. To be eligible for the 2013 Breeders' Cup Championships held at Santa Anita Park on November 1 and 2, 2013, all horses must be pre-entered by noon (Pacific Time at the designated pre-entry locations) on Monday the 21st of October, 2013. Winner must be nominated by pre-entry deadline to receive Challenge race awards. Weight for age. Three-year-olds, 120 lbs.; older, 123 lbs. Mrs. John E. Cowdin has donated a perpetual cup to be held by the owner of the winner for one year. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. (Clear 70)

PRINCESS OF SYLMAR away in good order, was reserved in the two path for the opening six furlongs, availed of the opportunity and after being let out a notch, slipped into the three path midway on the turn, crept up to be perched just off the leader's hind quarters heading into the stretch, responded eagerly when given her cue, poking a head down in front of a much more energetically-handled rival by the furlong marker, shook free, being primarily briskly hand ridden, while flashed the stick from the right side at intervals during the late stages. ROYAL DELTA kept watch on ROMAN INVADER from the two path, briefly matched strides on even terms with that opponent between the first and second calls before getting eased back into the role of primary pursuer, moved when ready coming to the midway point on the turn and powered her way to the front, not needing encouragement from the pilot, approached the quarter pole with the eventual winner poised to stride, began the drive lightly hand urged, was much vigorously hand ridden during the next sixteenth, fell back by a very slim margin with an eighth to go, was put to stick work thereafter, failed to re claim the lead and had to settle for being second best. CENTRING stumbled at the start, raced three to four wide on the turn, folded. AND WHY NOT lost her footing at the start, raced from off the rail and failed to menace. ROMAN INVADER edged away to a clear advantage by the end of the chute, was rated along the inside while showing the way, had the runner up draw on even terms briefly down the backstretch, had the same foe did likewise prior to the third fraction being set, was powerless to protect the lead, backed away steadily after getting displaced.
