GROUPIE DOLL, five wide under a snug hold early, edged up four wide within herself nearing the far turn, bid to join the leaders after a half mile, dueled three deep to the quarter pole, took over straightening for the wire, kicked away when put to strong urging leaving the three sixteenths marker, had her rider switch to the left stick in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and dug in gamely to hold off **JUDY THE BEAUTY**. **JUDY THE BEAUTY**, four wide stalking the early pace, brushed with **GREAT HOT (BRZ)** near the half mile marker, briefly threatened between foes into the far turn, initially failed to kick on with the dueling leaders past the three eighths marker, gave hard chase four wide into the lane, switched to her correct lead with a sixteenth to go, leveled off nicely and came back gamely between runners to be gaining on the winner. **DANCE CARD** broke a step slow, recovered and advanced along the rail after three furlongs, angled out for a clear run past the three eighths marker, circled five wide advancing into the stretch, ranged up outside the top pair with about seventy yards remaining then hung. **SUMMER APPLAUSE** settled off the rail, came under pressure mid turn, raced three wide into the lane and found her best too late. **SWEET LULU** cleared under rating leaving the chute, dropped down towards the rail after a quarter mile, was joined by **TEDDY'S PROMISE** and **GROUPIE DOLL** around the far turn, dueled, lost command mid turn, remained prominent past the three sixteenths pole then gave way. **DANCE TO BRISTOL**, under early rating four wide, gained some after a half mile, pursued the leaders to the head of the stretch but came up empty from there. **GREAT HOT (BRZ)**, forward four wide between horses early, brushed with **JUDY THE BEAUTY** when shuffled back past the half mile marker, regrouped to give chase around the turn but lacked a stretch response. **TEDDY'S PROMISE** angled to the outside of **SWEET LULU** when that one angled in after a quarter mile, lodged a two wide bid into the turn, dueled on a short lead between rivals mid turn, was displaced by the winner in upper stretch then weakened in the final furlong. **BOOK REVIEW** lacked speed, came four wide for the drive and failed to make an impact. **RENEE'S TITAN** saved ground while outrun. **ISMENE** flashed speed between horses and faltered. **STARSHIP TRUFFLES** was sent up inside leaving the chute, stalked the pace into the turn, failed to go on from there and gave way.
