CHRISELLIAM (IRE) broke slowly, tugged between horses then chased a bit off the rail, split rivals on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch, rallied under urging to gain the lead four wide nearing the sixteenth pole and won clear. TESTA ROSSI (FR) angled in and settled off the pace inside, moved up a bit off the rail leaving the second turn, steadied off heels into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch, came out and rallied for second late. COLONEL JOAN bumped and steadied at the start, stalked inside, came out for room leaving the second turn, split rivals a quarter mile out and rallied between horses late. MY CONQUESTADORY stalked outside then three deep, bid three wide leaving the second turn, took a short lead in the stretch, was between horses a sixteenth out and was outfinished. DANCING HOUSE angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, continued a bit off the rail into and on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. READY TO ACT had speed between horses then stalked a bit off the rail, bid between rivals leaving the second turn, fought back between foes until past midstretch and weakened late. VORDA (FR) six wide into the first turn, stalked outside then three deep, split rivals into the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the necessary rally. GLENOR (IRE) angled in and settled off the pace outside a rival then inside on the backstretch, split horses on the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. SKY PAINTER four wide into the first turn, chased outside, came out leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. NESSO broke out and bumped a rival, took the early lead just off the rail then set the pace inside, fought back leaving the second turn and until past midstretch, then weakened. KITTEN KABOODLE pulled between horses to stalk the early pace, continued three deep leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. GRANNY MC'S KITTEN five wide into the first turn, chased outside then four wide, shifted out on the second turn then angled three wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. STREET SAILING fractious in the post parade and in the gate, pulled between horses and steadied repeatedly into and on the first turn, chased off the rail, angled in leaving the second turn and had little left for the stretch. AL THAKHIRA (GB) squeezed back at the start, stalked inside, dropped back into and through the stretch, gave way and was eased late.
