SECRET CIRCLE, in range five wide between rivals early, eased back a bit leaving the far turn, altered six wide regaining momentum into the lane, rallied under left handed urging to collar GENTLEMEN'S BET nearing the sixteenth pole, kicked clear, drifted in from the right handed rousing then lasted over a fast closing LAUGH TRACK. LAUGH TRACK lagged off the rail, advanced three wide into the stretch, shifted out five wide in mid stretch and closed strongly to be getting to the winner. GENTLEMEN'S BET prompted the pace inside of SUM OF THE PARTS, assumed command into the turn, took pressure to the quarter pole, spurred away inside the three sixteenths pole, was taken on a sixteenth out and faded. MAJESTIC STRIDE, taken to rate while saving ground, made steady progress in mid stretch, angled out soon after and kept on willingly to the finish. JUSTIN PHILLIP was sluggish through the opening three furlongs while saving ground, awaited room entering the stretch, altered out inside the three sixteenths marker, bulled his way between runners late and closed the gap. BAHAMIAN SQUALL was in close soon after the break, advanced between runners nearing the quarter pole, swung out very wide for the drive and had a mild late response. FAST BULLET forced the issue four wide between rivals early, chased the dueling leaders three to four wide into the lane, came up empty and was brushed by JUSTIN PHILLIP late. WINE POLICE, in range six wide nearing the half mile marker, dropped in a path leaving the far turn, chased into the stretch then faded. TRINNIBERG raced very wide while not threatening and returned bleeding from the mouth. PRIVATE ZONE, three wide between runners forcing the early pace, pursued off the inside to upper stretch then retreated. THE LUMBER GUY broke slowly, saved ground around the turn and failed to menace. SUM OF THE PARTS sprinted to an early lead while two wide, took pressure from both sides before being headed into the turn, battled outside GENTLEMEN'S BET to upper stretch then faltered in the final furlong.
