SHARED BELIEF stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail into the second turn, bid three deep into the stretch to gain the lead, kicked clear and drew off under an energetic hand ride until the final stages. CANDY BOY between horses early, stalked off the rail, came out and moved up three deep leaving the backstretch then bid alongside a rival on the second turn to gain the lead, continued just off the rail into the stretch, drifted in and held second. TAMARANDO settled inside then went outside a rival leaving the backstretch, swung out four wide into the stretch and gained the show. BOND HOLDER chased a bit off the rail or inside, came out on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ELECTRIC EDDIE saved ground stalking the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. BROTHER SOLDIER pulled outside the winner to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the second turn, weakened and drifted out in the stretch. SHEIKINATOR chased between horses three deep into the first turn, continued outside on the backstretch, angled in alongside a foe on the second turn and did not rally. RANKHASPRIVILEGES four wide into the first turn, chased outside and four wide again leaving the backstretch, came into the stretch three deep and lacked a further response. EVEN ECHO chased between horses then outside a rival, found the rail into and on the second turn and weakened. KOBE'S BACK five wide into the first turn, angled in and chased outside rivals, came out a bit and clipped heels a half mile out, dropped back on the second turn, drifted four wide into the stretch and also weakened. TAP IT RICH broke slowly and awkwardly behind the field, was rank and swerved five wide into the first turn, continued off the rail throughout and failed to menace, then was eased in the stretch. KARMA KING had speed three deep then stalked outside a rival, dropped back and drifted wide on the second turn and was pulled up in the stretch. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident involving CANDY BOY and KOBE'S BACK a half mile out but made no change when they ruled the latter was the cause of his own trouble.
