**6 FURLONGS. (1.074) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 CICADA S. INNER DIRT FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. No nomination fee. \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. A supplemental nomination fee of \$2,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Certain finishing positions in the Cicada will earn points to qualify for the 2013 Kentucky Oaks, purs unt to the official rules for the Road to the Kentucky Oaks published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. The winner will earn 50 points, the second place finisher 20 points, the third place finisher 10 points and the fourth place finisher 5 points. Weight1 22 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstake or \$50,000 in 2013 other than restricted stake allowed 2 lbs.; two races other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. ELGHAYOOR chased the front pair three wide on the turn, got put to a prolonged drive, entered the stretch and closed the gap enough to latch on to the runner up with an eighth to go, forged to the front in the late stages and edged clear. HIGHESTMAINTENANCE disputed the pace from the outside, well rated for the opening half, got turned loose entering the turn, failed to go by a very stubborn foe in I'M MOM'S FAVORITE during the ensuing furlong, fought her way to a very slim and short-lived advantage by deep stretch, had it snatched away by the top one, continued onward willingly for the place. I'M MOM'S FAVORITE put to some light hand urging, had the rider switch over to a snug hold on the reins after securing the front, was prompted from the outside by an equally well-rated HIGHESTMAINTENANCE, raced as a team with that foe on nearly even terms during the run around the bend, arrived at the quarter pole and was asked for a response, clung tenaciously to a slim advantage all through the furlong grounds, with the eventual winner now lurking dangerously at this juncture, yielded reluctantly with about seventy yards to go. RAILTOWN GIRL departed the backstretch three wide, advanced steadily into contention making her way around the bend, while being widest of all for a good portion of that run, sustained the move until midstretch then flattened out. KISS THE LADY was bumped at the break, gave chase from outside, was two wide and under rousing by the midway point on the turn, made no headway and tired. SENSE OF REALITY made solid contact with KISS THE LADY at the start, underwent a ground-saving journey, tracked the front runners while being coaxed along, faltered.
