1 MILE. (1.32²) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 (Includes \$150,000 Starters Bonus) *CIGAR MILE H. (GRADE I) A HANDICAP FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.* No nomination fee with a guaranteed purse of \$500,000. \$5,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$10,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to the publication of weights. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$2,500 rebate. If any Breeders' Cup winner were to start in the Cigar Mile the purse for that horse would increase to \$1,000,000. If any Grade One winner were to start in the Cigar Mile the purse for that horse would increase to \$750,000. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, November 16, 2013 with 22 Nominations. (Cloudy 36)

Bay Horse, (Mar), by Flatter - Cresta Lil by Cresta Rider. Trainer Mott I. William. Bred by Nikolaus Bock(FL).

FLAT OUT settled into midpack, sat reserved from the four path for most of the way around the turn, picked up interest when asked coming to its end, entered the stretch and was asked for his best, gave it, arriving at the eighth pole as a serious threat, continued onward forging his way to the front a sixteenth later then edged away under good handling. PRIVATE ZONE established control shortly after the start, tucked into the two path and showed the way from there being rated along, came under intensified pressure just before the setting of the third fraction, appeared to be one getting clipped behind by CLEARLY NOW near the quarter pole, responded with determination when given his cue, got collared with about a sixteenth remaining, continued with good courage for the place. VERRAZANO sat forwardly placed from off the inside, checked while trying to allude a troubled CLEARLY NOW near the quarter pole, making contact with LAUGH TRACK, bumped a few more times with that same foe being angled outward for better racing room right afterwards, displayed a mild kick to earn the last major check. CLEARLY NOW tracked the pacesetter from the inside, sought access to the two path while in a bit tight coming to the quarter pole, failed to gain it, stumbled after clipping the leader's heels as three-quarters was being completed, recovered with enough interest to stay in contention for an additional eighth before weakening. FORTY TALES rode the rail down the backstretch, took the two path for most of the way on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, mustered up a mild response to mainly improve position. GOLDENCENTS in slightly at the start, bumped hard with CAPO BASTONE, coming out a bit at the same time, moved up into a forward position, patiently stalked the pacesetter towards the three path, bumped with VERRAZANO in upper stretch then backed away. SARATOGA SNACKS stumbled badly at the start, raced along the outside, drifted six to seven wide into the stretch while tiring. LAUGH TRACK bobbed at the start, raced from off the rail throughout, got bumped by GROUPIE DOLL prior to the quarter pole, made contact several times again in short order as that rival was being maneuvered outward, gave way. CAPO BASTONE bumped soundly at the break, saved ground for three-quarters, angled out three wide coming to the top of the lane, had no offering. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the incident in the vicinity of the quarter pole before the result was declared official.
