(GRADE I) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$300 each or by supplementary nomination of \$15,000 each by 12:00 noon (EST) Thursday, November 21, 2013. \$2,500 to pass the entry box; \$2,500 additional to start, with \$500,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights to be announced Friday, November 22, 2013. The maximum number of starters for the Clark Handicap will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to highweights, with consideration to the scale of weights for age. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Wednesday, November 13, 2013 with 19 nominations. (Cloudy 37)

WILL TAKE CHARGE settled in hand five wide, took closer order leaving the second turn, quickened under left handed urging in the final furlong and caught GAME ON DUDE in the last jump. The latter came away flat footed, pulled to contention toward the inside, shifted out on the backstretch, took over inside the three-eighths pole, kicked clear entering the stretch, kept on well but was turned away in the shadow of the wire. EASTER GIFT was allowed to settle, advanced between rivals through the second turn, tipped out five wide entering the stretch and continued on willingly to earn the show. BOURBON COURAGE was away slow, was unhurried into stride, circled seven wide but was left with too much to do. JAGUAR PAW was close up four wide, but faltered between horses leaving the second turn and faded. FINNEGANS WAKE broke slow, was unhurried, finished with a belated gain six wide between foes, but failed to threaten. OUR DOUBLE PLAY rushed to the lead, angled in to set the pace, was collared on the second turn, disputed the issue to the stretch and tired. GOLDEN TICKET saved ground to no avail. PRAYER FOR RELIEF was allowed to settle off of the inside, but came up empty on the second turn and dropped out.
