7 FURLONGS. (1.21) STAKES. Purse \$300,000 DEL MAR FUTURITY (GRADE I) FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS (FOALS OF 2011). By subscription of \$300 each if made on or before June 7, 2013, the fee to accompany the nomination, closed with 208. For horses not nominated, supplementary nominations of \$10,000 each will close at the time of entry, Saturday, August 31, closed with 1. All horses shall pay \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$3,500 additional to start, with \$300,000 Guaranteed, of which \$180,000 to first, \$60,000 to second, \$36,000 to third, \$18,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. Weights : colts and geldings, 122 lbs.; fillies, 119 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 allowed 2 lbs.; of a race other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs.; of a race other than claiming, 6 lbs. (Clear 84)

TAMARANDO chased off the rail then between horses, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up late. DANCE WITH FATE broke out and bumped a rival, moved up inside to chase the pace, was boxed in off heels into the turn, came off the rail leaving the turn and five wide into the stretch and finished well. CAN THE MAN had good early speed inside then ducked in at the gap, dueled along the rail, gained the advantage on the turn, inched away in the stretch and held on well but was caught late. ALBERTS HOPE was bumped between foes in a bit of a slow start, chased off the rail then three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied outside. GUNS LOADED stalked three deep then outside a rival, came out into the stretch and finished with interest between foes late. CALIFORNIA CHROME chased between horses on the backstretch and turn, rallied between foes in deep stretch and was in a bit tight off heels late. INDEXICAL dueled four wide then three deep, battled outside a rival leaving the backstretch and into and on the turn and weakened in the stretch. ALPINE LUCK had speed between horses to force the pace then stalked a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn and also weakened. RUM POINT prompted the pace between horses then stalked outside a rival or off the rail, dropped back and angled in some on the turn and had little left for the stretch. CELTIC MOON broke out and bumped a rival, stalked just off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and weakened. SKYDREAMIN broke out and bumped a rival in a bit of a slow start, settled inside, came out on the turn, was fanned five wide into the stretch and lacked a further response.
