7 FURLONGS. (1.202) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 EIGHT BELLES S. (GRADE III) FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$4,500 at time of entry. \$750 to pass the entry box; \$750 additional to start, with \$150,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or II stakes in 2013, allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade III or \$45,000 twice since December 25, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Eight Belles will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest career earnings. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Wednesday, April 10, 2013 with 45 nominations. (Cloudy 68)

Bay Filly, (Apr), by Sightseeing - Happy Scene by Dehere. Trainer Amoss M. Thomas. Bred by John R. Penn & John C. Penn(PA). SO MANY WAYS settled between horses, wheeled out six wide leaving the turn, quickened in the final furlong and was fully extended to narrowly prevail. FUSAICHISWONDERFUL was rank to place between horses, leveled into stride through the turn, came four wide to make her bid, was blocked near the furlong marker, split horses and kicked on well but just missed. IRISH LUTE tracked four wide, came five wide into the stretch, fought on through a prolonged drive, but wasn't quite good enough. CALISTOGA settled in hand, circled five wide to range into striking distance, loomed large with a furlong to run but flattened during the drive. BLUEEYESINTHEREIN disputed the pace three wide, fought on doggedly through a prolonged drive but grudgingly gave way in the final yards. SITTING AT THE BAR was forwardly placed along the inside, was bottled up through the turn, shifted out and split horses entering the stretch, angled back to the inside but flattened late. GUADALUPE HIGH stalked the pace, joined the vanguard four wide midway through the turn, but weakened between horses and faded. TOUCH MAGIC was unhurried into stride, came four wide and improved position through the stretch. GOLD MEDAL DANCER failed to respond. DANCINGINTHECIRCLE failed to threaten. CHORTLE set the pressured pace along the inside through the turn and wilted. NEITH was through after a half. RENEE'S TITAN bobbed at the start, was unhurried along the inside and was never a factor.
