Supplemental nominations of \$15,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$500,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Weight 121 lbs. Preference will be given in the following manner: Fir st preference to graded or group winners in order (I,II,III), then highest career earnings (non-restricted). Starters to be named through the entry box at usual time of closing. The Fair Grounds Oaks will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Failure todr aw into the race will cancel all fees. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, March 16, 2013, with 20 nominations. (Cloudy 75)

Bay Filly, (Mar), by Street Sense - Unlimited Pleasure by Valid Appeal. Trainer Pletcher A. Todd. Bred by Ocala Stud(FL).

UNLIMITED BUDGET went four wide on the first turn, settled comfortably just off the pace while on the outside, moved closer while four wide and under urging on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, gained the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, battled with FLASHY GRAY into the final furlong and edged clear under two cracks of a right-handed whip then hand urging in the final sixteenth. FLASHY GRAY went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, moved closer leaving the backstretch, raced three wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, gained a short lead at the quarter-pole, lost the advantage to the winner in upper stretch while under a drive, had the rider lose the whip near the furlong marker and was outfinished while clear for the place. SEANEEN GIRL saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved out midway down the backstretch, was roused while three then four wide on the far turn and safely secured the show while no match for the top two. PROMISE ME MORE dropped back at the start, raced off the rail on the first turn, was unhurried at the rear, saved ground early on the far turn while under urging, shifted three wide late on that bend, angled out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. SO MANY WAYS moved up after the start to take the lead, raced off the rail on the first turn, set the pace through quick fractions, was guided around the far turn while off the rail, lost the lead near the quarter-pole and gave way. BLUE VIOLET went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, raced off the rail on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to respond. ANTE UP ANNIE raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, was reserved along the rail, moved closer with a half-mile to run, saved ground on the far turn and came up empty.
