BETTER LUCKY settled in hand three deep, commenced her rally nearing the three-eighths pole, made a sweeping move four wide through the second turn, poked her head in front with a furlong to run and held DAYATTHESPA at bay through a prolonged drive. DAYATTHESPA tucked in at once, attended the pace toward the inside, got through leaving the second turn, came to level terms with a furlong to run, fought on determinedly but missed narrowly. DAISY DEVINE was away in good order, set the pace four wide, widened after a half, controlled the tempo through the second turn, was collared between horses entering the stretch, gave way but had enough left to safely preserve the show. MIZ IDA was allowed to settle, moved up four wide through the second turn to mount a mild bid, but flattened during the drive. HUNGRY ISLAND was unhurried into stride, settled saving ground, got through and improved position belatedly. SAY (IRE) was allowed to settle off the inside, took closer order through the second turn, but wilted entering the stretch and faded. WINDING WAY was close up five wide, came up empty before going six furlongs and dropped out. AMAZONAS (IRE) broke outwardly to get away slow and never recovered.
