A supplemental nomination fee of \$10,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to the closing of entries. All starters will receive a \$2,500 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Any horse that competes in both the Alfred G. Vanderbilt Hcp and the Forego or has placed in a graded sweepstake will have their entry fee waived for the Forego. Three year olds, 122 lbs.; Older 124 lbs. STRAPPING GROOM came away in good order, showed good natural speed, dueled on the outside of FAST BULLET, inched clear while three wide midway through the turn, drifted out under a drive in upper stretch, came under a right-handed whip, took a true course into the final sixteenth, drifted out some late and just held under strong handling. JACKSON BEND settled while under some urging, saved ground while ridden along on the turn, swung off the rail at the top of the stretch, rallied into contention near the three-sixteenths, came under a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker, closed well to loom a threat into the final sixteenth but missed. JUSTIN PHILLIP chased the pace on the outside, raced three to four wide on the turn, pursued the winner under a drive in upper stretch and weakened while able to get the show. LEA settled while under some urging, went three wide while under the whip on the turn and lacked the needed response. SAGE VALLEY was taken in hand early, raced in the middle of the field, came under urging outside the half-mile pole, was ridden along while off the rail on the turn and failed to rally. JAVERRE was urged along at the rear, went two then three wide on the turn and was no factor. FAST BULLET dueled on the inside of the winner while off the inside, vied off the rail early on the turn, dropped back with three furlongs to run, chased into the stretch and faltered then was pulled up quickly after the wire and returned walking gingerly. GOLDDIGGER'S BOY was ridden along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and was outrun.
