1 1/4 MILES. (Turf) (1.443) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 **HAWTHORNE DERBY (GRADE III) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS**. By subscription of \$100 each which shall accompany the nomination. A supplementary nomination of \$4,000 may be made at the time of entry, Wednesday, October 2, 2013 which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start, with \$200,000 Guaranteed; the purse will be divided 60 percent to the winning owner, 20 percent to second, 10 percent to third, 5 percent to fourth, 3 percent to fifth and 2 percent divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weights, Colts & Geldings, 122 lbs. Fillies, 119 lbs. Non-winners of \$100,000 at a mile or over in 2013, allowed 2 lbs.; Of \$55,000 at a mile or over in 2013, 4 lbs.; Of \$55,000 at a mile or over anytime, 6 lbs.; Of \$25,000 twice at a mile or over in 2013, 8 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered). A trophy will be awarded to the winning owner. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Nominations closed Monday, September 23, 2013 with 39. (Rainy 75)

Bay Colt, (Apr), by Lemon Drop Kid - Dreams by Silver Hawk. Trainer Drysdale D. Neil. Bred by R. S. Evans(ON).

KID DREAMS was rated in hand just behind the second flight along the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out three deep on the far turn while steadily advancing on the leaders, wrested a clear advantage midstretch and drew well clear under pressure. CHARMING KITTEN angled nearer to the inside early to track the leaders outside a rival in the second flight, shifted out on the far turn, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch but edged a rival for place honors late. FIVE IRON, urged to terms with a rival attending the pace in the opening half, pressed the issue between foes to upper stretch, couldn't match the winner but continued with a grudging effort to earn a share. DORSETT, reserved along the inside in the opening stages, split foes just off the inside while being roused to advance in upper stretch but flattened out late. ALWAYS CURIOUS tracked off the second flight early, was fanned six wide into the lane but continued willingly with a mild bid. LUKES ALLEY was settled between foes in the opening stages and lacked a rally. MONGOLIAN SATURDAY broke sharply, was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival racing to the far turn and gave way abruptly in upper stretch. ULTIMO TRAGO angled inside tracking just off the leaders racing to the backstretch but came up empty on the far turn. MORO TAP, caught in tight quarters at the start, never menaced. INFINITE MAGIC dropped out early.
