ROSE TO GOLD broke on top, took control past the wire the first time, set a moderate pace under light restraint up the backstretch, remained clear into the far turn, shrugged off a bid from FLASHY GRAY late in the final bend, shook clear again into the lane, steady handling to the wire. FLASHY GRAY chased the winner from the outside through the first turn, maintained contact with that rival up the backstretch, lodged a bid from the outside midway on the second turn, could not match strides in the drive, remained well clear for the place. AMERICAN SUGAR brushed start, unhurried early while saving all the ground, began to advance midway on the final turn, steered out for room, emerged from between rivals upper stretch, showed some late energy to be along for the show. LIBERTY GIRL four wide in the first turn, remained four wide while reserved up the backstretch, remained four wide through the second bend, managed to improve position slightly while widest in the drive, not enough for the show. SITTING AT THE BAR away in good order, settled off the pace and the inside, in some traffic far turn, advanced four wide into the lane, flattened out to lose the show spot in the late going. BROKEN SPELL within striking distance in the early going, had little left for the drive. SISTER GINGER fractious in the gate, off the pace and the inside, failed to muster a response in the drive. FLASH FORWARD brushed at the start, unhurried early, three wide middle move to get closest to the top two turning for home, gave way readily in the drive.
