

7 FURLONGS. (1.20²) STAKES. Purse \$300,000 *HUMANA DISTAFF S. (GRADE I) FOR FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$300 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$9,000 each by the time of entry. \$1,500 to pass the entry box; \$1,500 additional to start, with \$300,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I takes in 2013, allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade II stakes or \$60,000 since November 2, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Humana Distaff will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest 2012-2013 earnings. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations are required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Apr), by Street Sense - Lilly Capote by Capote. Trainer Nicks E. Ralph. Bred by James C. Spence(KY). AUBBY K shadowed the pace three wide, moved up to tackle JAMAICAN SMOKE in earnest midway through the turn, took over and shook clear entering the stretch, and held safely through the drive. BURBAN settled in hand, ranged into striking distance four wide, continued on willingly but was unable to bridge the gap. HOLIDAY SOIREE was allowed to settle, commenced her rally circling five wide and was making up ground readily. JAMAICAN SMOKE sprinted clear to dictate terms, was collared after a half, was unable to match strides with the winner, stayed on fairly well to the final furlong and faded. RUMOR was forwardly placed toward the inside, dropped off the leaders a bit leaving the turn, toiled on through the drive but failed to make headway. BYRAMA (GB) was unhurried into stride, came five wide to make a belated gain but was left with too much to do. EMMA'S ENCORE was allowed to settle three deep, came four wide but lacked a response when called upon. THERE IS NO LIMIT broke in the air to get away well behind her field, tucked in to save ground, angled out leaving the turn but was never a factor. SAME CROSS saved ground to little avail.
