Bay Gelding, (Apr), by War Front - Leave by Pulpit. Trainer Stall, Jr. M. Albert. Bred by Claiborne Farm & Adele B. Dilschneider(KY).

DEPARTING, reserved out of striking distance tracking off the second flight while angling inwards a bit nearing the first turn, shifted out six wide after a half, was urged to advance approaching the far turn, made a sweeping four wide run through the far turn to gain a clear advantage racing into upper stretch and extended his margin to the end under firm left handed encouragement. FORDUBAI, prompted to secure a forward placing racing four deep into the first turn, shifted nearer to the inside approaching the second bend commencing his challenge, disputed the issue between foes into upper stretch while shifting nearer to the inside in upper stretch, couldn't match the winner then swerved out in the closing stages crossing the path of ABRAHAM but continued under pressure to save the place honors. SIETE DE OROS settled out of striking distance while angling nearer to the inside racing to the first turn, shifted out sharply entering the backstretch carrying out STREET SPICE after the opening half, continued four, then five wide between foes racing through the far turn to upper stretch but split foes in that path late to prevail for a share. ABRAHAM bobbed at the break while being bumped, was held up off the second flight a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out five deep midway through the backstretch advancing to contention nearing the second bend, continued to force the issue three deep between foes into upper stretch, flattened out nearing the furlong marker and was forced to alter course avoiding FORDUBAI in the closing stages while giving way. STREET SPICE, off a bit slowly and held up out of close quarters at the start, shifted outside foes racing to the backstretch, was caught eight wide after the opening half while being carried out, continued to make steady progress racing six wide through the far turn to upper stretch but finished evenly in late stages. FOR GREATER GLORY, caught in close quarters at the start, settled between foes in the opening stages, was fanned four, then five wide racing through the far turn but continued to improve position in that path to late stages. NARVAEZ was rated off the second flight racing to the first turn, shifted out sharply entering the backstretch while being prompted to gain brief contention four wide bid between foes racing into the second bend, continued three deep between foes to upper stretch and came up empty. DEWEY SQUARE was urged along in the opening stages to gain a contending position, tracked just off the first flight along the inside racing into the far turn, was shuffled a bit entering the second bend when caught behind a tiring foe and lacked a closing response. GROUND TRANSPORT sped to the fore while shifting to the rail racing to the first turn, disputed the pace inside foes for a half and emptied out entering the second bend while steadying in traffic. BELLS BIG BERNIE, reserved nearest the rail in the last flight while racing in tight quarters approaching the first turn, shifted off the inside to gain some position racing into upper stretch but never gained contention. SHOW SOME MAGIC tracked the leaders three deep between in the second flight racing to the far turn and emptied out nearing upper stretch. STORMIN MONARCHO settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch and never mounted a serious challenge. TAKEN BY THE STORM gained a forward placing attending a rival's pace while racing off the inside in the opening stages, moved to press the issue nearing the far turn while shifting to the inside, dueled inside foes for six furlongs and emptied out racing into the stretch. DAKOTA MAC broke outwards bumping ABRAHAM, was righted to gain a position between foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch but retreated from contention early.
