A supplemental nomination fee of \$10,000 in addition to the entry fee can be made at any time prior to the publication of weights. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$2,500 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, September 21, 2013 with 41 Nominations. (Clear 74)

Bay Colt, (Feb), by Stormy Atlantic - Song of the Lark by Seeking the Gold. Trainer Pierce Malcolm. Bred by Sam-Son Farm(ON). UP WITH THE BIRDS hung out three wide on the opening bend, remained well off inside throughout, crept up after leaving the midway point on the far turn, was cued up and unleashed a four wide run from the five-sixteenths marker, maintained the momentum spinning into the stretch, briefly drafting behind NOTACATBUTALLAMA, tipped slightly wider and was called upon for his best, gave it, making good progress on the cluster of rivals directly up ahead, outkicked them all to gain a sliver of a lead with about a sixteenth remaining, edged away kept to a drive. ADMIRAL KITTEN away with no apparent mishap, was quickly sent over to the inside route, steadied when momentarily in tight along hedge shortly afterwards, vacated the premises leaving the backstretch, picked up interest when asked to prior to the end of the second bend and swung outward, kept getting fanning wider and wider traversing through the furlong grounds until about eight wide with an eighth to go, had a good finish down the outside of the course en route to garnering the place. JACK MILTON contently rode the hedge, had the pocket sitter, than being MILLS, slip into the two path a couple of jumps prior to the quarter pole, availed of the newly-created rail passageway but for a moment, tipping out a bit himself, checked when caught in tight quarters in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, got going in short order, was between rivals scurrying to a slim and short-lived advantage past the eighth pole, continued on gamely to take the show. NOTACATBUTALLAMA well rated while undergoing a three to four wide journey, was given his cue after a few strides into the stretch drive, lacked the needed late closing punch. JOHA patiently prompted the pacesetter from the outside, challenged turning for home, gained a head lead at eighth pole, relinquished soon and weakened. STORMY LEN raced between rivals on the first turn, raced one path wider on the subsequent one, closed the gap and challenged in earnest heading for home, fought with vigor to be nearly on the front end with an eighth to go, failed to sustain the move and backed away slightly in the late stages. MILLS was rank under stout restraint for much of the opening half mile, got eased into the two path with a couple of jumps to go before reaching the quarter pole, had no pick up when set down. WAR DANCER raced three wide on the far turn, was rallying when forced to take hold after encountering traffic near the sixteenth pole, altered course outward and flashed some belated interest. BALANCE THE BOOKS between rivals on the far turn, was caught in traffic coming to the eighth pole. GLOBAL ASSET saved ground to no avail. MICHAEL WITH US raced along the outside and offered little. GET IN LINE off to an alert start, was sent over to the inside, showed the way with JOHA keeping watch on the outside, came under heavier pressure coming to quarter pole and was put to a drive, resisted the pressure for an additional sixteenth before giving way.
