ON FIRE BABY bore in at the start and bothered inner rivals, alternated for the lead outside the winner but was outfinished. BELIEVE YOU CAN, bothered at the start, raced close up while off inside and lacked a late bid. CLASS INCLUDED, close up while three wide, held on well to the stretch and tired. MORE CHOCOLATE, bumped early and squeezed back, angled out four wide on the first turn when close up, maintained her position to the stretch and tired. IMPOSING GRACE, outrun for six furlongs, was not a threat. DRAW IT wide throughout, was not a factor.
