TRICKY HAT (CHI) , patiently handled, advanced between horses leaving the far turn, was three deep at the head of the stretch, bulled his way between horses in midstretch, gained the lead inside VITIUM approaching the sixteenth pole and narrowly prevailed. EAGLE POISE lacked speed, circled foes the final turn, entered the lane six wide and rallied nicely. MUCHO MAS MACHO advanced in the five path turning for home, had aim on the lead in midstretch then flattened out between horses. VITIUM stalked the pace, was four deep when gaining the lead leaving the final turn and weakened late. HARRODS CREEK , wide while never far back, had aim on the lead leaving the final turn and weakened in the drive. DANNHAUSER showed no speed, raced wide the final turn and failed to menace. LAKE DROP raced between horses and failed to rally. ROYAL BENCH (IRE) lacked speed, was checked in tight quarters near the three eighths pole, worked between horses and finished willingly. LONELY WHISTLE stalked the pace, was two wide leaving the final turn and gave way in midstretch. ATIGUN lacked speed, saved ground much of the race, hugged the rail entering the stretch and was checked in tight quarters near the eighth pole. DON CAVALLO , sent to the early lead, saved ground setting the pace, weakened and was steadied in midstretch. CUL BAIRE (IRE) was outrun. VALTER was done entering the final turn then dropped back.
