1¹ MILES. (Inner Turf) (1.573) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 WOODFORD RESERVE MANHATTAN H. (GRADE I) INNER TURF A HANDICAP FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$5,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$10,000 in addition to the entry fee can be made at any time prior to the publication of weights. All starters including supplements to receive a \$2,500 rebate. The purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Any horse that competes in both the Woodford Reserve Manhattan and The Man o' War will have their entry fee waived for the Man o' War. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. POINT OF ENTRY settled four wide in mid pack, came under coaxing three furlongs out and advanced steadily into prominence at the top of the stretch, got set down straightened away confronting OPTIMIZER, rallied battling head to head between foes as REAL SOLUTION joined them on the outside a furlong from home, dug in gamely inching away in the final strides to prevail as the trio widened away from the rest. OPTIMIZER tracked from the three path in closest pursuit of the front, came under urging midway on the far turn, took command just prior to the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch confronted by the aforementioned rival, clung stubbornly to the lead until headed narrowly a furlong out, fought on with good effort inside a pair to the wire just holding for the place unable to match the winner solely in the final strides. REAL SOLUTION well held early on to settle in mid pack, lost some position progressing down the backside and came under light coaxing at the seven-sixteenths to pick it up, advanced steadily back into contention set down four wide in upper stretch, rallied to join the top pair the outermost of a trio battling through the final furlong while widening away from the rest with good energy to the wire. FINNEGANS WAKE off a step slow, crossed to the inside soon after the start, saved ground through the first turn, angled out to be three wide down the backside, came under urging three furlongs out continuing three wide, shied from the whip in the stretch running a bit erratic while offering up a mild bid in the late stages for the last major share. TWILIGHT ECLIPSE broke out at the start and was corrected before making contact with FINNEGANS WAKE, settled two to three wide in mid pack, improved position nearing the half mile pole into the far turn being ridden along, remained prominent to the head of the stretch and steadily weakened in the drive. PLAINVIEW on the pace in hand just off the inside, came under light coaxing midway on the turn, yielded the front at the five-sixteenths, faded from contention nearing the quarter pole then weakened in the stretch. SIDE ROAD coaxed along three wide towards the rear, shifted to the hedge three furlongs out continuing a long drive and made no impact. BOMBAGUIA just off the pace three wide in pursuit ridden along from the half mile pole, retreated through the latter portion of the turn and tired.
