LIAISON prompted the pace outside a rival then stalked on the backstretch, re-bid alongside that foe on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away in midstretch and proved best under urging. KETTLE CORN settled just off the inside then saved ground off the pace on the backstretch and second turn, came out into the stretch, angled back to the rail in midstretch and finished with interest inside. GUILT TRIP stalked inside then a bit off the rail, went between horses early on the second turn then outside a rival leaving that turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. BLUESKIESNRAINBOWS sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, inched away on the backstretch, fought back when challenged again on the second turn and into the stretch, came a bit off the fence in the drive and weakened but was edged for third. MIDNIGHT TRANSFER three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival then three wide on the second turn and into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. VAGABOND SHOES (IRE) stumbled at the start, angled in and pulled his way along inside chasing the pace, continued along the rail on the second turn, came out some in the stretch and weakened.
