The purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Any filly that competes in both the Acorn and Mother Goose will have their subscription fee waived for the Mother Goose. 121 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. CLOSE HATCHES away with no apparent mishap, remained well off the inside throughout, was let out a notch coming to the half mile pole and instantly picked up the pace, cruised up towards the leader from the four path and displaced that rival a few strides before arriving at the five-sixteenths marker, extended the margin the rest of the way around the bend, turned for home comfortably in front of the remaining quartet all of whom were under a drive, got set down herself, scampered away to win decisively, crossing the wire under mild hand urging. DREAMING OF JULIA near the inside during the initial stages, got tipped into the two path, continued to race from along the outside thereafter, fell back despite getting asked for run in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, was taken outward and eventually spun four wide into the stretch under a drive, continued onward to get up for the place, while never posing a threat to the top one. MARATHON LADY underwent a ground-saving journey, was under a drive cutting the corner into the stretch, got outfinished for second. TOASTING was lightly hand urged to secure the early advantage, cut the pace from the two path, kept to some light coaxing while undergoing the task, had no answer when the winner went rolling by leaving the midway point on the turn, was set down prior to the quarter pole, gave way. SISTER STATE chased three wide, was put to strong handling by the five-sixteenths pole, folded.
