Non-winners of a Graded Race at One Mile of Over since October 6 allowed 3 lbs.; Non-winners of a Graded Race at One Mile or Over, 5 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Bay Filly, (Ma), by Smart Strike - Scarlet Tango by French Deputy. Trainer Hollendorfer Jerry. Bred by Stonestreet Thoroughbred Holdings LLC(KY).

SCARLET STRIKE stalked outside a rival, moved up three deep on the second turn then four wide into the stretch, bid outside the runner-up in midstretch, gained a slim advantage under urging in late stretch and gamely prevailed. BIRDLOVER (GB) had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside past the wire the first time then spurted clear on the first turn, set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, fought back just off the fence through the final furlong and continued gamely to the wire. SWEET RED CAT chased inside then split horses three deep on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch, drifted in some but got up between foes for the show. FLASHY WAYS broke a bit slowly, angled in and settled outside a rival, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and found her best stride late. SARACH broke inward, went up between horses to duel for the lead then stalked a bit off the rail to the stretch, was between foes through much of the final furlong and was outfinished for a minor share. KYRIAKI saved ground stalking the pace, bid inside in the stretch but lacked the needed late kick. MAGNIFICENT SHIRL chased outside a rival, was in tight between foes early on the second turn, continued between rivals then a bit off the rail in the stretch, was in a bit close off heels in deep stretch and was outfinished. AKISS FORAROSE lunged at the start to be away a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WITTGENSTEIN (IRE) went up three deep to press the pace then stalked outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. SULTRY SEASON squeezed back at the start, settled inside chasing the pace, continued along the rail on the second turn and weakened.
