(GRADE II) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS.* By subscription of \$300 each to accompany the nomination closed with 2. \$4,500 additional to start, with \$300,000 guaranteed. The winner to receive \$180,000 PLUS 50 KENTUCKY DERBY POINTS, \$60,000 to second, \$36,000 to third, \$18,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or Grade II race at One Mile or Over allowed 3 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade III race at One Mile or Over, 5 lbs. \*Early bird nominees to the 2013 Santa Anita Derby (Closing Date: December 2, 2012) are automatically eligible to the San Felipe Stakes with all fees waived closed with 123. (Clear 64)

**HEAR THE GHOST** chased outside a rival then off the rail, came out into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up late. **FLASHBACK** came off the rail on the first turn and pulled his way up three deep to vie for the lead, dueled outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, was floated out while taking a short lead into the stretch, brushed with that foe in upper stretch, inched away and drifted inward in deep stretch and was caught late. **TIZ A MINISTER** allowed to lag back just off the rail for six furlongs, swung four wide into the stretch and closed willingly. **GOLDENCENTS** pulled along the inside then tugged his way up between foes into the backstretch, dueled inside, came off the rail into the stretch, brushed with the winner, drifted back in and weakened some late. **SALUTOS AMIGOS** went up three deep early, took the lead, inched away and angled in, dueled inside then stalked the leaders, came out into the stretch and weakened. **CARVING** settled inside, went outside a rival on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and did not rally. **OMEGA STAR** chased outside a rival then off the rail, angled in on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed response. **KOCHEES** broke in and bit awkwardly, chased three deep then off the rail, angled in on the second turn and weakened.
