JOYFUL VICTORY inherited early lead into first turn from along the rail, set pressured pace from the inside, edged away early on and around the final bend then stretched that margin under steady handling to score convincingly. MORE CHOCOLATE caught four wide into initial bend, was guided over and secured the inside later on the turn, stalked inside, was hard asked around final bend to remain close then lost contact with winner but drew away from rival to proved second best. BRUSHED BY A STAR unhurried early from the inside, saved ground chasing the pace, was taken off the rail and stalked while outside rival on the second turn then weakened some in the stretch. GREAT HOT (BRZ) broke alertly and grabbed brief early lead, drifted out slightly into first turn, pressured the pace through the backstretch, continued off the rail, dropped back from between rivals and faded. SNOW FALL between rivals and three wide early, tracked the pace from off the rail and on same path to final turn, was taken hold off the dropped back suddenly on that turn then pulled up and walked off.
