TANNERY (IRE) contently tracked the front runners while saving ground, began to range up upon departing the backstretch, had JULIE'S LOVE abandon the pocket coming to the quarter pole, arrived at that station with clear passage for the asking and availed of the opportunity, responded positively when given her cue, slipping by inside the pacesetter to take over during the run through the furlong grounds, showed good determination in the late stages to fend off the belated challenge of ANJAZ to preserve the decision. ANJAZ got away a beat slowly after lunging at the start, settled at the back of pack and contently bided time until the end of the backstretch, advanced into contention with a run along the two path making her way from the top of the far turn to the quarter pole, spun into the stretch then altered course sharply to be four wide a sixteenth later, settled into her best stride, closed in with good energy but had to settle for the place. MINAKSHI (FR) shook free of the field under her own power making her way down the homestretch, was sent over towards the inside about halfway around the first turn, rated kindly showing the way on a loosely-contested lead, kept at a slight distance from off the rail, felt the pressure building up late on the far turn and was soon called upon, drifted out a bit to commence the stretch two wide, got overtaken by the winner soon afterwards, continued onward in a willing manner to secure the show. JULIE'S LOVE (GB) sneaked over into the pocket coming to the half mile pole, saved ground for nearly the next quarter pole, was cued up and angled back to the outside coming into the lane, got outfinished. MYSTICAL STAR stalked the pacesetter from the two path during the initial stages, lost position to HESSONITE midway down the backstretch, chose the three path as the one to take around the far turn, lacked the needed response. HESSONITE swung three wide into the backstretch, looped MYSTICAL STAR and moved up to become the primary pursuer proceeding towards the half mile pole, chased the pacesetter from the two path, fell back slightly and was asked for some run in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, tired steadily after turning for home. STRATHNAVER (GB) raced along the outside and was outrun. STARFORMER was taken off the rail after leaving the first turn, tired.
