By subscription of \$750 which should accompany the nomination. \$5,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$6,250 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$11,250 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided as follows \$400,000 to the winner, \$140,000 to second, \$75,000 to third, \$50,000 to fourth, \$30,000 to fifth and \$22,500 to sixth, \$17,500 to seventh and \$15,000 to eighth. 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$500,000 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Graded Sweepstake, 4 lbs.; of two races at a mile or over other than maiden, claiming or starter, 6 lbs.; such a race at a mile or over, 8 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, May 24, 2014 with 25 Nominations. (Clear 80)

SWEET REASON raced towards the inside during the initial stages, slipped into the two path past the midway point on the turn, remained well in hand the rest of the way to the top of the lane, got cued up and proceeded to alter course in the direction of the middle of the strip a short distance past the three-sixteenths pole, settled into her best stride, drew even with about a sixteenth to go, took over and edged away. SWEET WHISKEY assumed a forward position, got rated in the two path to the quarter pole, arrived at that station with clear sailing and launched her bid, emerged at the end of the furlong grounds as the new leader, got confronted in earnest by the top one shortly afterwards, relinquished in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, continued onward with good energy to secure second. UNBRIDLED FOREVER off the inside throughout, left the three-eighths pole three wide, rallied willingly to take the show award. FIFTYSHADESOFGOLD rated kindly three wide while cutting the pace around the turn, feeling the presence of others all the while, was let out for the drive home, yielded before completing the next furlong, steadily weakened thereafter. TIZ SO SWEET three wide, drafted behind the leader on the turn, that being FIFTYSHADESOFGOLD, was lightly coaxed riding time nearing the quarter pole, got called for run soon afterwards, lacked the needed response. HOUSE RULES contently rode the rail until nearing the five-sixteenths marker, got taken outward angling wider and wider until about six wide by the end of the maneuver, failed to gain ground appreciably. MY MISS SOPHIA lost her footing leaving the starting gate, pressed the issue primarily from the four path travelling around the turn, swung into the stretch as wide as before, had no response and backed away. ARTEMIS AGROTERA five wide at the midway point on the bend, tired. FASHION PLATE was lightly hand urged from the starting gate to secure a prominent position, began to back away soon after going a half. RISQUE REALITY brushed at the start, was never involved. LADY PARADIME made light contact with RISQUE REALITY as the field was sent on its way, departed the backstretch taking the three path, gave way. VERO AMORE took the overland route to no avail. EUPHROSYNE was taken hold of after breaking slightly to the outside, raced from off the inside, arrived at the quarter pole under a protective hold and was eased down the stretch.
