By subscription of \$600 each which should accompany the nomination; \$4,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$6,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 121 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, August 2, 2014 with 19 Nominations. (Cloudy 77)

STOPCHARGINGMARIA bumped with SIZE at the start, established forward position soon after, went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid while three wide on the far turn, turned into the stretch on even terms with two opponents, was put to a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker, fought with MISS BESILU, inched clear at the sixteenth-pole, was switched to a left-handed whip and held under strong urging. JOINT RETURN raced in the two path on the first turn, was reserved towards the rear, came under urging before the half-mile pole, saved ground on the final turn, cut the corner while gaining into the stretch, moved out under a right-handed whip at the three-sixteenths, rallied on the outside and closed well under continued right-hand urging but was too late. MISS BESILU came away well then eased back once confronted with outside pressure from SIZE, was rated just off the pace on the inside, responded well when asked at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner to make a rail bid at the quarter-pole, battled under a right-handed whip into the final furlong and was outfitted while able to get the show. FORTUNE PEARL went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along with a half-mile to run, raced two then three wide on the far turn, turned into the stretch under the whip, brushed with an opponent while splitting horses outside the furlong marker, shifted out late and finished willingly. GOT LUCKY raced inside on the first turn, was unhurried at the rear, came under some urging outside the half-mile pole, was ridden along while towards the inside on the far turn, brushed with FORTUNE PEARL outside the furlong marker and improved position. AMERICA moved out on the initial straightaway, went three wide on the first turn, settled on the far outside, chased four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and weakened. CATCH MY DRIFT raced just off the pace while off the rail and between rivals, was urged along while still between horses on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch and tired. UNBRIDLED FOREVER was taken in hand after breaking well from the inside post, raced in the two path on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide early on the far turn, moved to five wide at the five-sixteenths, came six wide into the stretch and failed to respond. SIZE bumped with STOPCHARGINGMARIA at the start, moved up to take the lead while dropping in, set the pace while a bit off the inside, was asked at the five-sixteenths, lost the lead at the quarter-pole and faded.
