SHARED BELIEF had speed between horses then was fanned out into the first turn, stalked outside, went up five wide into the second turn, angled in outside on that turn, came out four wide into the stretch, gained the advantage outside the runner-up in midstretch and held on gamely under urging. FED BIZ sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled on the backstretch, regained the advantage into the second turn, inched away from foes a quarter mile out, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, fought back inside the winner through the final furlong and continued gamely to the end. FOOTBRIDGE angled in and settled inside chasing the pace, went up between horses leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, continued inside leaving that turn, bid along the rail in the stretch and bested the rest. MAJESTIC HARBOR settled outside then off the rail, continued outside on the second turn and a bit wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. IMPERATIVE angled in nearing the first turn and saved ground chasing the pace, came out on the backstretch, bid between horses nearing the second turn and three deep on that turn, fell back some approaching the stretch and weakened. MYSTERY TRAIN (ARG) four wide early, angled in on the first turn, bid between horses into the backstretch, put a head in front while dueling outside the runner-up, battled between rivals into the second turn, continued just off the rail leaving that turn and also weakened. SKY KINGDOM drifted out some into the first turn, stalked off the rail then between foes leaving the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
