MR SPEAKER stalked the pace off of the inside in hand, waited patiently in traffic leaving the second turn, shifted out entering the stretch, assumed command inside the furlong marker and quickly drew clear. DIVINE OATH brushed the gate and was away slowly, settled toward the inside, moved out five wide after a half to commence his rally, continued on willingly and was up in time to earn the place. SUPERMONIC vied for the lead four wide, fought on through a long drive, was no match for the winner, fought on but failed to hold his stable mate at bay for the place spot. AMI'S HOLIDAY tracked the pace four wide, was collared between horses on the second turn, weakened slightly during the drive and gave way. SOLITARY RANGER was away in good fashion, disputed the pace along the inside, contested the issue to the final furlong and wilted. POKER PLAYER was unhurried into stride five wide, shifted out further but lacked a response when called upon. Z LUCKY was allowed to settle five wide and was never a factor. RIDE AWAY was unhurried into stride, tucked in to save ground under a tight hold and showed little.
