WISE DAN was unprepared at the start, finally settled in along the backstretch after fighting restraint into the first turn, began his bid into the far turn, swung into the six path entering the lane, continued his rally mid-stretch from the six path and swept past the leaders in the final stages. GRAND ARCH stalked the pace early, fanned into the five path in the far turn, made a strong bid inside the eighth pole but hung under pressure in the final stages. SAYAAD tracked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn, stuck his head in front through the stretch run and led late but yielded in the final stages. KAIGUN was unhurried early, shifted into the four path in the far turn, made a bid while rallying in the stretch run but flattened out late in the drive. SILVER MAX set the pace early, angled into the three path entering the lane and faltered late in the stretch run. SEEK AGAIN bobbed at the start and trailed the field early, angled off the rail into the far turn, made a bid to the rail in the upper stretch but altered out through the sixteenth pole and came up empty late. OPTIMIZER chased the pace early, was on the inside entering the lane, drifted out a bit through the stretch and faded late. TWO NOTCH ROAD was through after a half.
