(Folios of 2012) Early Bird Nomination Fee of \$400 due by Saturday, December 20, 2014, which includes nomination fee for Lecomte Stakes (Gill) and Risen Star Stakes (Gill) (Early Bird). Final nomination for Louisiana Derby closes Saturday, March 14, 2015 by subscription of \$750. \$3,750 to enter, \$3,750 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$20,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$750,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weight: Colts and Geldings 122 lbs. Fillies 117 lbs. Preference will be given in the following manner: First preference to graded or group winners in order (I,II,III), then highest career earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Louisiana Derby will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference will be refunded the entry fee or supplementary nomination fee if applicable. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, March 14, 2015, with 86 nominations. (Clear 70)

Bay Colt, (Mar), by Fusaichi Pegasus - Parlez by French Deputy. Trainer Michael J. Maker. Bred by Katharine M. Voss & Robert T. Manfuso (NY).

INTERNATIONAL STAR was given a tug of the left rein at the start to keep him from breaking out, went three wide early on the first turn then dropped to the rail, settled off the pace, moved up midway down the backstretch, raced inside on the far turn, slipped through inside of FUSAICHI FLAME when that rival vacated the rail around the five-sixteenths, shifted off the rail while gaining at the top of the stretch, made a bid at the three-sixteenths, dueled with the runner-up under a right-handed whip in the final furlong and gamely prevailed under strong urging. STANFORD went to the front, raced in the two path on the first turn, set the pace through sensible fractions, vied along the rail while under some urging on the far turn, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip near the eighth-pole, dueled gamely with the winner in the final furlong and just missed. WAR STORY raced in the two path on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, advanced under a right-handed whip into upper stretch, was switched to a left-handed whip while drifting in at the three-sixteenths pole, chased the top two into the final furlong and flattened out while able to get the show. KEEN ICE went three then two wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, moved out some in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. FUSAICHI FLAME raced inside on the first turn, was well spotted just off the pace, dropped back while inside early on the far turn, came off the rail in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole and tired. ST. JOE BAY went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch while under the whip and weakened. DEFONDO raced inside on the first turn, lagged at the rear, was urged along while inside on the far turn and failed to threaten. A DAY IN PARADISE was rated while three wide on the first turn, passed the five-eighths pole under urging, was ridden along while two to three wide on the far turn and came up empty. MR. Z went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased in the two path on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and stopped.
