1 1/8 MILE. (1:43⁴) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 Risen Star S.FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$400 by Saturday, February 7 (Louisiana Derby early bird nominees automatically subscribed); \$2,000 to enter, \$2,000 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$8,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$400,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a grade I or II stakes allowed 2 lbs, a sweepstakes at a mile or over, allowed 4 lbs, \$27,000 twice at a mile or over allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Risen Star Stakes will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest lifetime earnings at the time of passing the entry box. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee or supplementary nomination fee if applicable. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, February 7, 2015, with 90 nominations. (Cloudy 68)

INTERNATIONAL STAR went three then two wide early on the first turn then dropped to the rail, settled in the middle of the field, drafted behind BLUFF while inside early on the far turn, accelerated past that rival while skimming the rail at the five-sixteenths, squeezed through inside of ST. JOE BAY to make a bid in upper stretch, edged clear inside the furlong marker and prevailed under strong urging. WAR STORY broke a bit slow, raced inside early on the first turn, moved out behind INTERNATIONAL STAR midway through that bend, settled well back on the backstretch, was urged along passing the half-mile pole, advanced three then four wide on the far turn, rallied outside in upper stretch, made a bid at the furlong marker but was outfinished while clear for the place. KEEN ICE went four wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along in the two path on the far turn, dropped to the rail outside the quarter-pole, cut the corner into the stretch, moved out in the vicinity of the furlong marker and finished willingly to just get the show. ST. JOE BAY set the pace on the inside, was asked nearing the quarter-pole, lost the lead while under a drive in upper stretch and weakened then caught for the show. IMPERIA went three wide on the first turn, settled well back while on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, moved out under a left-handed whip nearing the furlong marker and failed to threaten. BLUFF saved ground on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was ridden along while a bit off the rail on the far turn and failed to rally. TIZNOW R J raced in the two path on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, chased into upper stretch and weakened. BIG BIG EASY went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four then five wide on the far turn and failed to respond. HERO OF HUMOR raced three wide on the first turn, moved up early on the backstretch to contest the pace, was urged along in the two path on the far turn and capitulated.
