The winner to receive \$240,000 PLUS 50 KENTUCKY DERBY POINTS, \$80,000 to second (20 KY DERBY POINTS), \$48,000 to third (10 KY DERBY POINTS), \$24,000 to fourth (5 KY DERBY POINTS) and \$8,000 to fifth. 123 lbs. DORTMUND had speed outside a rival then angled in, dueled inside, inched away on the second turn, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, fought back when challenged again, drifted out from the whip a sixteenth out when edging away again and proved best. PROSPECT PARK four wide early, stalked three deep, angled in some leaving the second turn, came out in midstretch and finished with interest to gain the place. BOLO between horses early, stalked outside a rival then bid three deep on the backstretch, tracked the winner outside on the second turn, bid again alongside that one in the stretch, steadied off the heels of that foe a sixteenth out and was edged late for second. LORD NELSON saved ground stalking the pace, bid inside on the backstretch, continued along the rail on the second turn and in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. THE GOMPER pulled between horses and steadied nearing the first turn, stalked between rivals, continued outside a foe leaving the second turn and did not rally. PULMARACK four wide early, chased three deep to the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. PAIN AND MISERY a bit slow to begin, settled off the rail then angled in leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch and did not rally. OCHO OCHO OCHO was in a bit tight just after the start, pulled inside and steadied then came out into the first turn, angled in and stalked along the rail to the stretch and weakened. SIR SAMSON prompted the pace outside the winner then between foes on the backstretch, dropped back between rivals on the second turn and also weakened. KENJISSTORM broke a step slowly, pulled between horses then stalked a bit of the rail, continued between foes again leaving the backstretch, also dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
