By subscription of \$600 on Friday, February 6, 2015 for The Southwest, The Rebel and The Arkansas Derby, \$2,000 to pass the entry box and \$2,000 additional to start, with \$300,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the Owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally between remaining starters. WEIGHTS: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 at a mile or over in 2015, allowed 3 lbs.; \$50,000 at a mile or over at any time allowed 5 lbs.; \$30,000 at any distance, allowed 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered). In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2015 Kentucky Derby, pursuant to the official rules for the Road to the Kentucky Derby published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. FAR RIGHT broke in, bothered slightly into the first turn, settled toward the inside, traffic, angled out four wide midway on the final turn, dropped to the inside nearing the furlong marker, challenged, dug in gamely late to prove best. THE TRUTH OR ELSE bothered slightly into the first turn, continued to lack speed up the backstretch, made a big move five wide into contention through the final turn, challenged while widest stretch, outkicked in the lane going, gained the nod for the place. MR. Z broke sharp, dueled briefly off the inside, shook clear before a half under restraint, responded when challenged second turn, held on stubbornly while between rivals the final furlong. BOLD CONQUEST bothered slightly at the start, got out a bit into the first turn, raced well back, asked along in the far turn, came six wide turning for home, finished willingly while too late. HILLBILLY ROYALTY broke outward but alertly, dueled briefly inside, took back, moved out, rebid in the second turn, vied into the stretch, faltered in the late going. MAJESTICO off a step slow, raced well back for six furlongs, passed some tiring rivals after the issue had been decided. PRIVATE PROSPECT bothered at the start, raced in mid pack, in some traffic while four wide late in the final turn, failed to rally when clear for the drive. BAYERD within striking distance along the inside, came up empty for the drive. PHENOMENAL PHOENIX in the second flight while between rivals, backed up through the stretch. KANTUNE closest to the leaders while racing three wide, gave way in the drive. BOLD ANIMAUX was finished early.
